



## How to Participate in the Development of Ontario's Long-Term Affordable Housing Strategy

The Ontario government is inviting residents, housing partners and other stakeholders to take part in the development of its long-term affordable housing strategy for Ontario. The strategy will be the first of its kind in Ontario and offers an important opportunity to create a bold new plan to ensure stable and affordable housing for all Ontarians.

### Ways to Have Your Say:

There are a variety of ways to have your say between *now and December 31, 2009*.

#### ① Attend a consultation session and express your views in person.

A consultation will take place in **Scarborough** on:

Two consultations will take place in **downtown Toronto** on:

**July 22 – 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 to 9:30 p.m.**

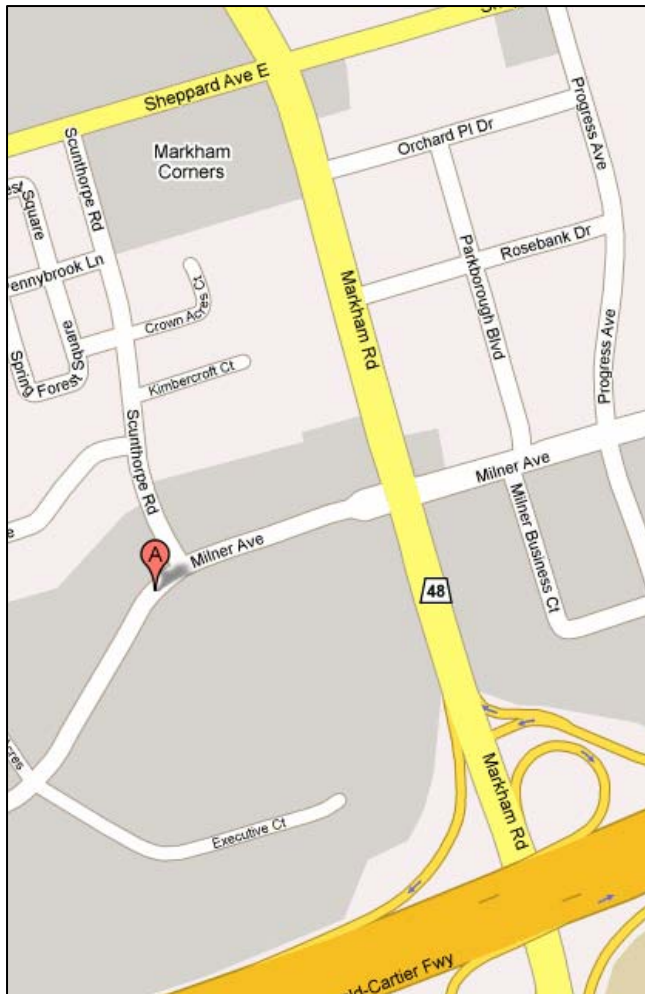

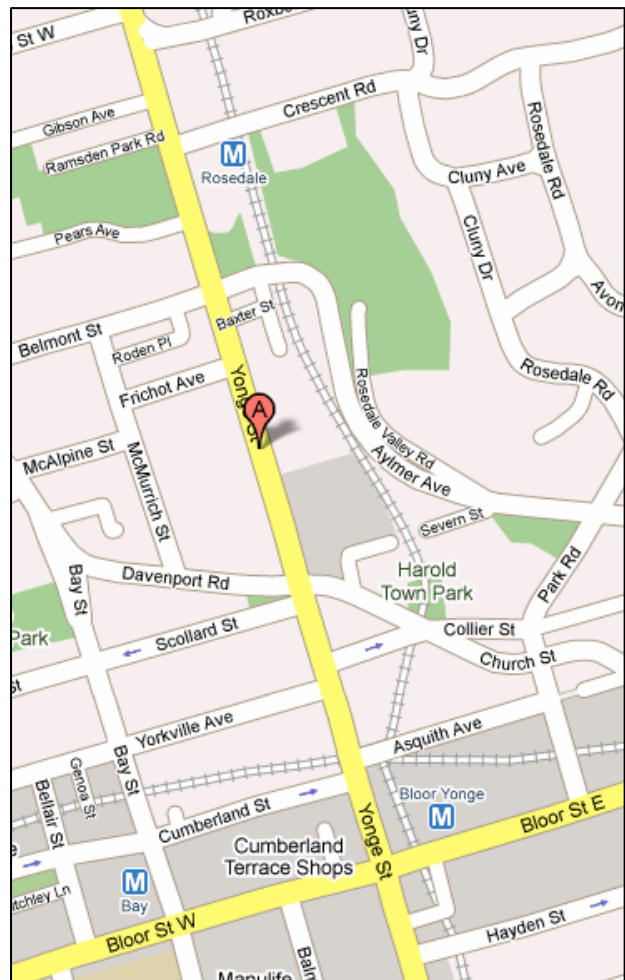
